




Autism-Europe makes a new easy-to-read website



Autism-Europe has made a brand new website.




We designed the new website for the **needs of disabled people**.



We finished it in September 2017.










The new website can do many more things than the old website.

In fact, we have a whole easy-to-read website!




On this website we follow the **advice** of the organisation <u>Inclusion Europe</u>.

This way we make sure the information is as clear as possible.




This website uses **pictograms** to make things easier to understand.



To find the easy-to-read version, go to the main page of our website and click on this picture.








Or you can go to the website directly by <u>clicking here</u>.

There is also a **forum for autistic people**.


A forum is a place on the internet where **people can talk**.

We hope you will **enjoy** using our new website.









European leaders accept the 'Social Pillar' to make a fair society



On the 17 November 2017 leaders from Europe had a big meeting in Sweden.



We call this meeting a 'summit'.



It is where leaders make big decisions.








At this summit leaders accepted something called the 'EU Social Pillar'.



The Social Pillar is a plan to show countries if they are doing enough to help all people.




It shows countries if they are supporting people in the correct way.



It shows **countries** if they are doing **enough to help people** have a **good quality of life**.







It shows countries if people with disabilities are **getting the support they need.**



It also shows if each country if people who work are treated in a **fair way**.




Autism-Europe is happy that leaders accepted the Social Pillar.



The Social Pillar will help people with disabilities.







Decision makers **are already making new laws** to
help people with disabilities



For example, soon the European Union will make a law to give people a good balance between work and home life.



The law would **help parents and carers** of people with disabilities.







The law would also help people with disabilities.








It will help because the **people caring for people with disabilities** will not be as tired.



Parents and carers will be less stressed.




This way they can give **better support** to people with disabilities.

In October 2017 Autism-Europe had a meeting in the city of Madrid, in Spain.




The meeting was hosted by our member *Autismo España*.




The group having the meeting is called the "Council of Administration".






This group makes important decisions for Autism-Europe.

People at the meeting learned about the new **Spanish strategy for autism.**




The strategy is a plan in Spain to better support autistic people in all areas of life.

In the meeting people also learned more about Autism-Europe's **next International Congress.**




The Congress is a big event that will happen in **2019** in the city of **Nice in France**.

They met with Autism-Europe's autistic representatives.




They also spoke with Autism-Europe's director **Aurélie Baranger.**








Together they talked about their experiences.



They also talked about what things are important for autistic people.




They talked about what work they want to see Autism-Europe do in the future.
