every year.









World Autism Awareness Day.





on 2 April.









A campaign has many activities that help spread a message to people.




Our campaign helps people understand autism better.

Find a tool that stand for what you can do best.




You can take a picture or make video with this tool.



You can explain what you do to support inclusion of people with autism into society.




